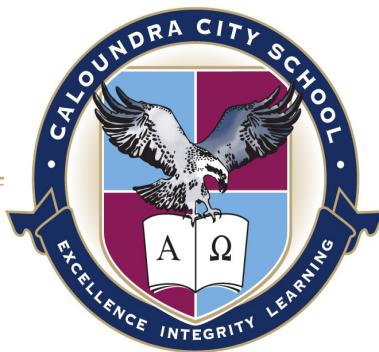

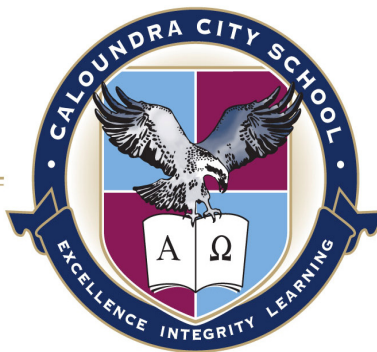
IN CONSIDERATION of the foregoing and of the school allowing our son/daughter to participate in the activity referred to above:
